Ooh Sha-la-la-la The Man In The Moon

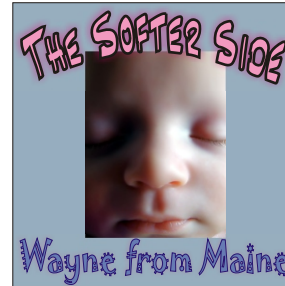
Magpies And Dragonflies

 Silly As A Seagull In The Sycamore Tree

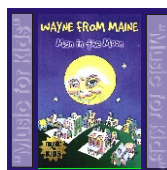

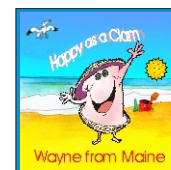
